“What is a sofa but a pile of pillows for maximum comfort? Turning the habitual modularity of sofa design into a virtue, the Brick explores the tectonic of bricklaying to stack sandbag-like cushions into architecture for comfort.”

KiBiSi set out to make a sofa with strong architectural references since KiBiSi partner Bjarke Ingels couldn't really find the right architect's sofa for his apartment. The point of departure was a classic brick bond forming the cushion pattern.

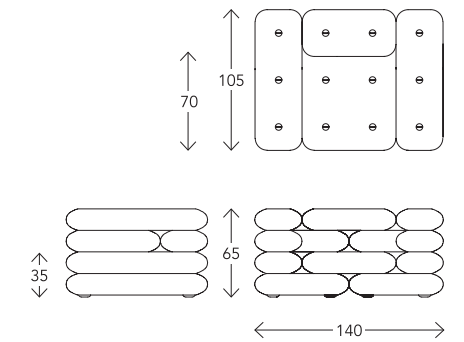


This architectural sofa is obviously an unparalleled focal point in any modern and contemporary home.

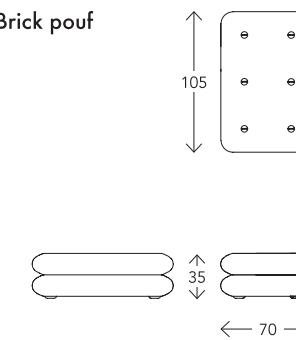
The cushions are tied together and fixed with a tailor quality button, which is molded of fiber concrete – yet another architectural reference.



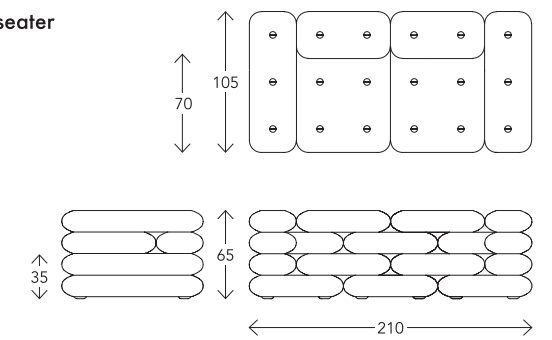
Brick armchair



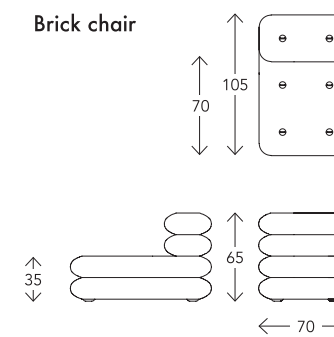
Brick pouf



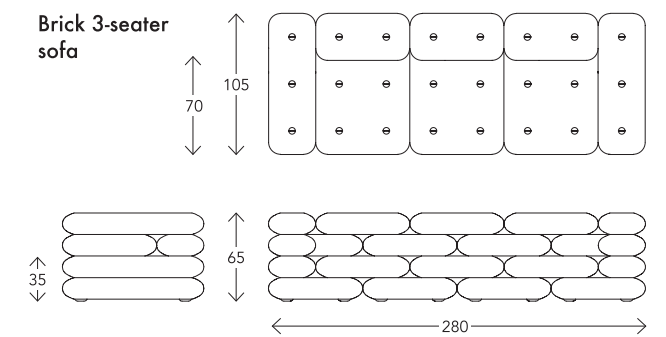
Brick 2-seater sofa

**Materials:**

Natural wool fabric, custom made fiber concrete buttons.

**Fabric details:**

Designed by Nanna Ditzel for Kvadrat.

Composition: 70% new wool, 30% viscose.

Environment: complies with EU Ecolabel. Long life span.

Benefits of wool: wool is a renewable resource and ages with grace.

Abrasion: approximately 100.000 Martindale rubs, EN ISO 12947.

**Process:**

Sandbag-like cushions made of upholstered foam. Bricklaying design fixed up with tailor quality buttons made of fiber concrete and tied with a rope.

**Button rope options:**

- 1 - sky blue
- 2 - ebony black

**Textile upholstery options:**

- 3 - Hallingdal 65-110
- 4 - Hallingdal 65-130
- 5 - Hallingdal 65-180
