


"What are you creating? If your answer is 'solutions', then this is an ending. But if you answer: 'I am creating possibilities', then it is an opening."

When Peter J. Lassen developed the Montana System, there was a detailed mathematic and philosophical principle behind it. The mathematic calculations are complex and based on 5.7 cm, but the philosophy is quite simple: Every Montana element should be able to be infinitely combined and be practical, good-looking, durable and independent of changes in fashion. That is the way it has been since 1982, and that is the way it will stay.

Since 2007, we have exclusively used water-based lacquer colours, which neither smell nor contain harmful solvents

At Montana, we take our environmental responsibilities seriously. Over 25 years ago, we introduced our own set of environmental accounts in consultation with The Danish Environmental Protection Agency and became one of the first Danish businesses to run 'cradle-to-cradle' analyses of the environmental consequences of a given product. Since 2007, we have exclusively used water-based lacquer colours, which neither smell nor contain solvents. Montana carries the Danish Indoor Climate Label, and Montana is certified in accordance to international environmental standards.




